SHEEP SECTION

Special Regulations Applying to Sheep Section in Addition to General Society Rules

- Maedi-Visna Accredited Flocks Scheme**– Entries will only be accepted from Non-Scheme Sheep
- Exhibitors must ensure that all sheep are transported and exhibited in accordance with current Defra regulations.
- Scrapie Monitoring**—This is a Defra approved show for scrapie-monitored sheep. The show will be approved as a scrapie-monitored event. It is a condition of entry that stock being exhibited is not pregnant, has not aborted or lambed within the thirty days prior to the show, and has not been subject to procedures which alter the breeding season.
- Dipping**—Exhibitors are responsible for complying with Dipping Regulations in force at the time of the Show, and **MUST** produce any necessary certification to Society Officials.
- Docking**—The Mutilation (Permitted Procedures) (England) Regulations 2007 detail that in all cases sheep must have enough of the tail retained to cover the vulva of female sheep and the anus of male sheep. Any sheep which does not comply with the aforementioned legislation will not be eligible to be shown in the judging ring.
- FMD Biosecurity** - It is a condition of entry that exhibitors comply with DEFRA requirements and the show's biosecurity plan. Details will be issued to exhibitors with entry tickets and passes. Showground holding no: 24/108/8000
- Entry Fees** - Classes 1 - 12: £3.50 per entry. Championship Classes: no entry fee.
- Prizes:** Classes 1–9 -Rosettes will be offered in all classes with prize money for with entries of:

- All sheep must be halter or collar-led when being moved on the Showground for any reason
- Acknowledgement of entries:** no acknowledgement will be sent on receipt of entries. Tickets and passes will be sent immediately prior to show.
- Judging:** All judging will take place on Saturday 24th July 2021, commencing at 9.30 am
- Ownership of Entries:** Entries must be the bona fide property of exhibitors at the date of entry. Exhibitors should attend with animals on judging day only, unless overnight arrangements are made with the Hon. Sheep Secretary.
- All animals must be shown in accordance with the relevant Breed Society rules and regulations
- Covid 19.** It is a condition of entry that all exhibitors comply with Government regulations and any Society Regulations
