NOTES:

- Class 2 will be split into colt and filly foals if there are three or more of both sexes forward
- Class 3 will be split into geldings and females if there are more than three of both sexes forward
- Any class with more than seven entries forward will have one extra prize awarded for every entry above the seven
- There will be a premium of £25 awarded to each entry that appears before the Judge, except in Class 7 & 9—subject to a maximum of £50 per horse
- Young Handlers are aged 12 and over, but not 18 on the day of the show. They will be expected to prepare their horses prior to judging

This class is open to pure bred fully registered Shires of two years old and over that are entered and exhibited in their appropriate breed classes at this show. This class will be run in accordance with the general rules as set out in the Horse of the Year Show rulebook, a copy of which can be downloaded from www.hoys.co.uk.

Exhibitors please note that the HOYS entry fee of £18 is payable for this class and the HOYS entry form is required in addition to that for the Show.

SHIRE AND HEAVY HORSE RULES:

- 1 The use of sawdust above the knees; use of resin, soap or other substance in any form or way designed to give an artificial appearance; cording or any other means adopted in showing an animal, will act as a disqualification
- 2 The Committee reserve the right to cancel and classes for which sufficient entries are not received.
- 3 In all Classes the exhibit must have been the bona fide property of the owner, since at latest, the 30th June preceding the Show
- 4 All animals for exhibition must be on the Show Ground by 9.30am on Show Day and must not be taken away until after the Grand Parade in the Main Show Ring
- 5 In Foal Classes the date of foaling must be given on the Form of Entry
- 6 Any entry omitted from the Programme shall not prejudice any award that may be made to such competitor

The Committee or any Officer thereof shall not be held responsible for any damages sustained by any animal or attendant, either by accident or otherwise.
