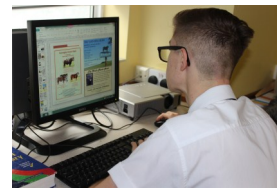


The Making of the first Lincoln Red Journal at Boston High School

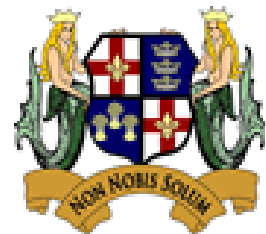
