ENTRIES for children, 5 and above, received by 2nd July will receive a free Competitor ticket giving free entry to the showground.

VEGETABLES and FLOWERS

16 YEARS AND UNDER

The competitor winning the most points will receive a cup.

Entrants must be 16 or under on the day of the show.

- 400 Dwarf beans - 5 (uniform length and width)
- 401 Radish - 3 (the biggest, all the same size, with 3 cm of foliage)
- 402 Spring onions - 3 (the roots trimmed and leaving 15cm of green top)
- 403 Potato - 3 of any one variety (same size and weight and clean/good to eat)
- 404 Vegetable tray - 3 different vegetables and 3 of each (tray/board not to exceed 45x60cm)
- 405 1 Vase of any 6 flower blooms grown by the exhibitor (any varieties)

How do I enter?

Either fill in the entry form and return it to Heckington School, Heckington Pre-School or to 9, Cowgate, Heckington by 2nd July.

Entering the running races by July 2nd entitles the runners who are over 5 to free entry with a Competitor ticket.

What if I am late?

For late entries for the Running Races (entries after July 2nd), either enter online or take your form directly to Sally Pinchbeck, 9, Cowgate, Heckington by 4.00pm on Wednesday 21st July.

Running entries received after July 2nd will not receive a Competitor ticket.

What do I do to take part?

CRAFT AND DESIGN and VEGETABLES AND FRUIT

Deliver your exhibit to the Showground between 6 and 8.30pm on Friday 23rd July.

The pedestrian and vehicular access from Eastgate will be open at these times.

RUNNING RACES:

If you enter before July 2nd you will be given an Competitor's ticket, in advance, to get into the Showground through any gate.

Come to the Showground on Saturday morning and be at the Children's Sports Tent on the opposite side to the commentary box by 9.30am* (time to be confirmed)

If I win?

Prizes for the sports will be given out straight away.

Details about trophies in the Horticulture tent will be displayed on the notice-board in the Horticulture tent.

Can I keep my Exhibit?

Yes, it can be collected after 5.00 p.m. on Saturday 24th but cars will not be allowed onto the showground to collect exhibits until Sunday.

We are delighted the Show is taking place, some things will be the same and some will be different.

What will be different?

- It will just be on Saturday July 24th.

We really wanted to have a show this year but as we were planning it we did not know what the Covid regulations would be. Having the Show for just one day will help us to meet all the expected regulations.

- Only half the Show field is available.

The rest of the field has been ploughed up for this year. The sections of the show will be smaller to allow as many sections as possible to be represented.

- There aren't so many classes to enter.

The horticultural marquee has had to be smaller to fit in as many sections as possible. The sides of the marquee will have to be open this year. We are therefore unable to have classes for items that can be spoilt in the unlikely event of rain or wind (!)

- There won't be a Grandstand this year.

This is to help people remain socially distanced.

What will be the same?

- There will be lots to do and see

Many sections of the show eg Livestock, Tradestands, Heritage will be represented so there will be lots to see and do.

- The Concert and Fireworks will take place on Saturday evening.

The Show ticket will include the Saturday evening concert and fireworks..

- Both children and adults can take part.
