

## TERMS & CONDITIONS

- The show committee aim to provide a safe, friendly and enjoyable event for participants and visitors.
- We expect anyone visiting the show to conduct themselves with normal common sense, consideration for others and have due regard for both their own safety and that of others around them in the full knowledge that they are visiting an agricultural show under the generally accepted definition of such an event.
- Our Health and Safety Policy is monitored and regulated by the relevant authorities and a copy of the full document is available on site for inspection.

The following terms and conditions apply:

**Online Ticket Orders-** Tickets purchased online are for entry for the dates stated only and are non transferable.

*Each ticket will be a separate page. Please ensure you have printed ALL your tickets*

*Only one print out of each ticket can be used and once scanned the tickets are no longer valid*

*The tickets are electronically validated on entry and subsequent or duplicate presentation constitutes fraudulent use.*

*You must bring the tickets with you to the show. Please keep them safe and dry. To avoid delays at the gate, the ticket should be presented individually by the user of the ticket*

*The tickets are valid only for the day(s) shown on the ticket and unless stated only for one day*

*E-ticket holders will not receive a swing badge in the post - these are only available for direct purchase from the ticket outlets in Heckington village*

### **Lost, Forgotten or Unused Badges/Tickets**

*No duplicate can be issued or any refund made in respect of any lost, forgotten or unused admission tickets or badges. Exhibitors & entrants should purchase a ticket at the gate and contact their relevant sub-secretary for further information. Refunds are not automatically given and are at the discretion of the Committee.*

### **General Conditions of Entry**

*The Committee reserves the right to cancel or change any event held at the show*

*Betting is strictly prohibited*

*The decision of the Judges is final & no delays by competitors will be allowed. Heats may be arranged to save time at the referee's discretion*

*The grounds are, by their very nature, uneven; care should be taken whilst moving around the show fields. The Committee will not be responsible for any accident or damage to competitors, spectators or their property*

*Cars are parked at the owner's risk & dogs must never be left in unattended vehicles.*

*The Committee reserves the right to postpone or cancel the Show in the event of inclement weather. We will endeavour to refund all entrance fees and tickets if the show is cancelled. Please see the Trade Stands information for the tradestands cancellation policy.*

*Expenses or additional costs will not be paid to any person in the case of postponement or cancellation.*

*The Committee reserves the right to refuse admission to any person or persons to the grounds*

*Unauthorised sale of alcohol or other goods is strictly prohibited. Alcohol purchased at the on-site bars must only be consumed within the bar area.*

*Photographs and images of people and events taken at the show may be used by the Committee for publicity purposes*

### **Cancellation or Abandonment of the Event**

*Heckington and District Agricultural Society shall accept no liability whatsoever for any losses suffered by applicants, entrants, visitors or stallholders in the event that the Heckington Show is cancelled, or if there shall be any alteration to its date or venue at short notice or otherwise.*
